About Pnima

We're looking for a warm, joyful, and creative Lead Facilitator to guide our weekly Shabbat morning children's program and help bring our vision of generational, soulful community to life.

Weekly Shabbat Role (9:00-12:00)

Time	Activity
8:30AM - 9:00AM	Setup children's space
9:00-10:00	Bring down food items for kiddush. Greet families and support free play in a welcoming, spiritual, and inviting setting (parental supervision required).
10:00-11:30	Lead Tefillat Yeladim, followed by parsha - and holiday - related engagement; facilitate age-specific group time when relevant. Programs may include (but are not limited to) We will welcome kids into the shul for a "mazel tov" and return to the Children's program to continue learning about smachot afterwards, until kiddush. Learning can include dance circles, trivia, a kiddush, or more.

11:30–12:00	Bring the children upstairs for kiddush and remain available to families during kiddush while assisting with light cleanup.

Year-Round Responsibilities

In addition to weekly facilitation, we want someone who will help **shape the heart and voice of the children’s program** throughout the year, including:

Curriculum Development	Writing an inspiring curriculum that harmonizes with the cycle of Jewish life – bringing Torah stories, holiday preparation, songs, and parshat hashavua alive for young hearts.
Logistics & Admin	Obtaining and organizing materials/kiddush needed to support and run weekly programs. Funds for doing so will be provided by Pnima. Bringing down materials and putting away on Shabbat, facilitating a Kids Kiddush (mizonot/grape juice provided but setup needed) as well as ensuring the toys remain stocked and usable. Purchasing and restocking as needed.
Team Building	Hiring, training, and mentoring junior facilitators as the program grows – helping build a warm, capable team rooted in Pnima’s values of community, creativity, and Torah living.
Flexible and growth-oriented	We are working to build a growing vibrant community in Jerusalem. As such, our needs are growing and evolving. We are looking for someone versatile and willing to grow with us, and help our community in doing so!

*We value transparency and teamwork - Yael will be available for support on all of the above, especially as you get started or expand into new initiatives.
